DSL Leading all matters connected to safeguarding and child protection.



Mrs Faulkner

Supporting the DSL, especially if the DSL is out of school. As SENCO Mrs Faulkner will also lead on the education and welfare of SEND pupils.



Mrs Lilley

ELSA Lead on the emotional and well-being of all Inmans pupils, identifying and providing additional support as appropriate.



Mrs Walker

Family Liaison officer Develop relationships with families that may need additional support. Manage attendance levels and provide advice to staff and parents regarding medical conditions in school.



Mr Hanson

The role of the safeguarding governor is key to understanding the effectiveness of safeguarding for everyone in the school. The safeguarding governor should understand the requirements of safeguarding guidance and legislation, and are 'confident in their challenge to executive leaders on strategies for monitoring and improving the behaviour and safety of pupils.' (Competency Framework for Governance (DfE 2017)).
