Pupils should be taught to:

- ❖ Develop their techniques, including their control and their use of materials.

Knowledge

- ❖ Know how to use a range of materials within drawing.
- ❖ Know how to select materials appropriately to create products.
- ❖ Know which materials are needed to create a mask including painting and sculpture.
- ❖ Know which materials and colours to use for a landscape.
- ❖ To know which materials to use for different purposes within painting, for example using different textures and brush strokes.
