## National Curriculum Objectives

Pupils should be taught to:

#### **Knowledge**

- Plan a sculpture through drawing and other preparatory work. Work on their own, and collaboratively with others, on projects in 2 and 3 dimensions and on different scales.
- Use ICT.
- Investigate art, craft and design in the locality and in a variety of genres, styles and traditions.
- Compare ideas, methods and approaches in their own and others' work and say what they think and feel about them.
- Adapt their work according to their views and describe how they might develop it further.
