Knowledge

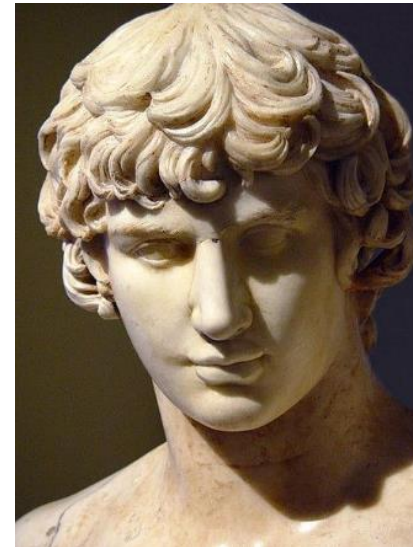
- ❖ know how to create a 3D sculpture using clay to improve mastery art techniques.
