- ❖ Describe the location of features and routes on a map.



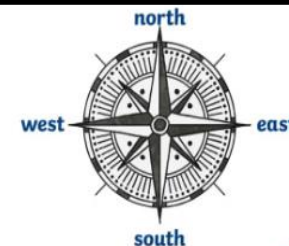
Knowledge:

- ❖ There are five oceans in the world these are: Pacific Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Indian Ocean, Southern Ocean and Arctic Ocean.
- ❖ There are seven continents in the world these are: North America, South America, Australasia, Africa, Europe, Asia, Antarctica.
- ❖ The directions of a compass are north, south, east and west.
- ❖ Some famous pirates are: William Kidd, Blackbeard, Anne Bonney, Black Bart.
- ❖ Pirates sailed ships around the world.
- ❖ Pirates wore gold and silver jewellery because they believed it gave them good eyesight.
- ❖ Some pirates wore an eyepatch. It is believed that they did this to make each eye stronger so they could see in the dark.
- ❖ Pirates followed maps around the world.
